How to register...

1. Decide between school- day or part- day for your child.
2. Go to the school of your choice.
3. Bring the following documents with you:
 - Original birth certificate with raised seal or passport
 - Current physical health form
 - Two proofs of residency: driver's license, utility bill, lease or notarized letter from landlord stating that you/ your family lives at a specified address.

For School Day Programs only:

A fee is charged for most of these programs.

To calculate the fee for your child please bring all that apply:

Proof of Income for both parents: Income tax form (1040) or W2s, 3 current paystubs, Unemployment Benefits Letter, State Assistance Benefits Letter, SSI, Foster Care payments
