Dear Mr. Skomro:


As the interim superintendent of the City of Bridgeport Public Schools, I am writing to the Connecticut Department of Public Health (CTDPH) to request permission to perform asbestos abatement during partial student/children occupancy at the above referenced facility. Asbestos abatement activities will be conducted from Monday, April 13, 2015, to Friday, April 17, 2015, from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM.

Abatement activities are being conducted under a project design written by Kevin McCarthy of Fuss & O'Neill EnviroScience (EnviroScience). Mr. McCarthy's Connecticut Department of Public Health (CTDPH) Project Designer license number is #000274. The abatement contractor is SMI Demolition, Inc.; a CTDPH licensed Asbestos Abatement Contractor (CTDPH license #000659).

Abatement is scheduled to commence within the first floor women's dressing room (100 SF of floor tile and mastic), basement incinerator room (1 incinerator unit and 10 SF of pipe fitting insulation), and the stand alone portable classroom building (800 SF of ceiling tiles, 30 SF of floor tile, 250 SF of roof flashing, and 50 SF of roof cement). All abatement activities will have project monitor services performed by an EnviroScience project monitor licensed by the CTDPH.
